
Drinking and Driving Survey Results November 2018




1. Overview of current report





It is critical to note that although many respondents believe it is easy to bribe an official, it is illegal. Individuals receiving or paying a bribe can face a fine, imprisonment for up to 18 years, or both.ⁱ In 2017 a City of Johannesburg metro police officer was sentenced to three years' imprisonment with the option of paying a R5 000 fine after accepting a R100 bribe.ⁱⁱ Following traffic laws is the simplest way to avoid encounters with traffic officials.





Although the dangers of driving drunk have been well documented, driving tired can be equally fatal. According to November 2018 research conducted by the British Automobile Association, one in five major accidents are caused by tiredness.ⁱⁱⁱ As the festive season approaches, it is vital that drivers take regular breaks and stop and rest when tired. The AA recommends stopping and resting every two hours, or 200km.
