Night Time Driving Survey Results**



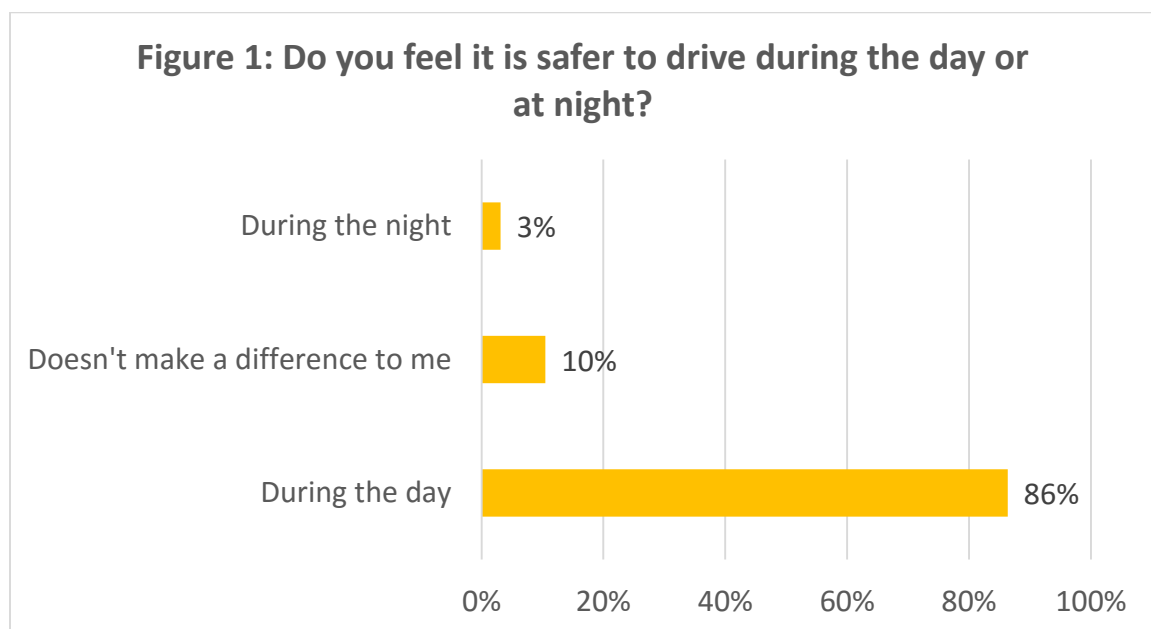
1. Overview of current report

The current report highlights the insights acquired from the AA night time driving survey. Topics under investigation include: how often South Africans drive at night, challenges experienced while driving at night, and the driving ability of South Africans in various scenarios (while driving at night).

2. Key findings

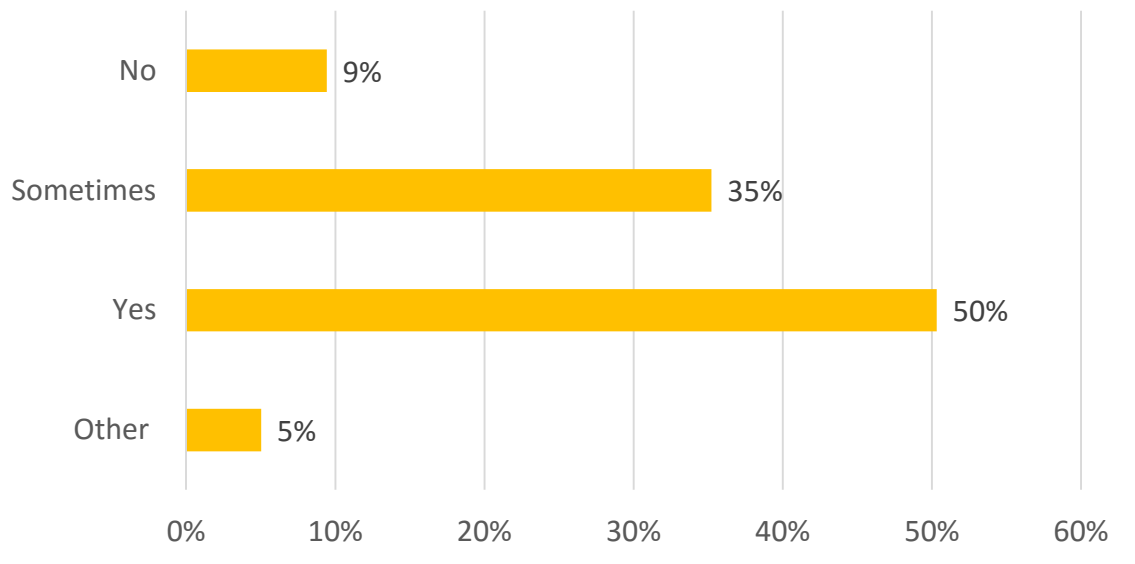
Overall, respondents recognised the inherent dangers of driving in the evenings. At least half of the respondents have indicated that night time driving is indeed a challenge. Despite this finding, 64% of respondents indicated having to drive in the evenings more than two days per week. When it comes to self-reported driving ability, above 41% of respondent indicated that they were *'above average'* to *'near perfect'* when it comes to driving at night, however when asked to judge the driving abilities of fellow road users, it was indicated that 45% and above were *'below average'* or *'poor'*. Finally, 84% of respondents felt that the most concerning threat one can face while driving at night is having to share the road with drunk drivers.

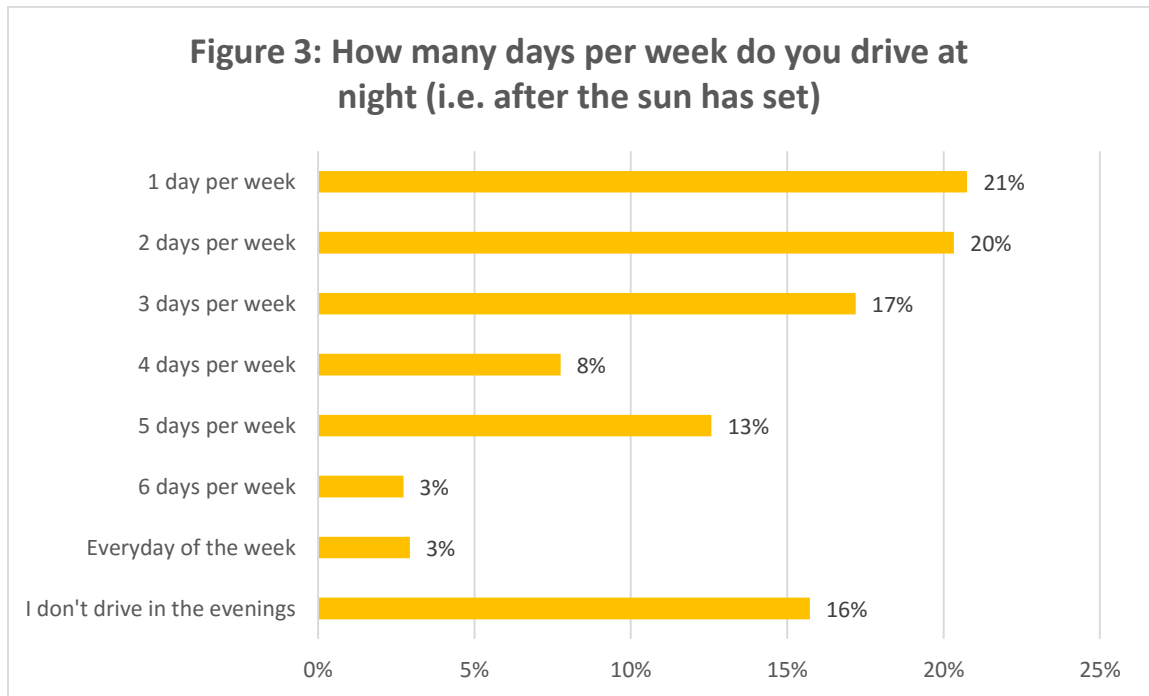

Figure 2: Do you find driving at night to be challenging?



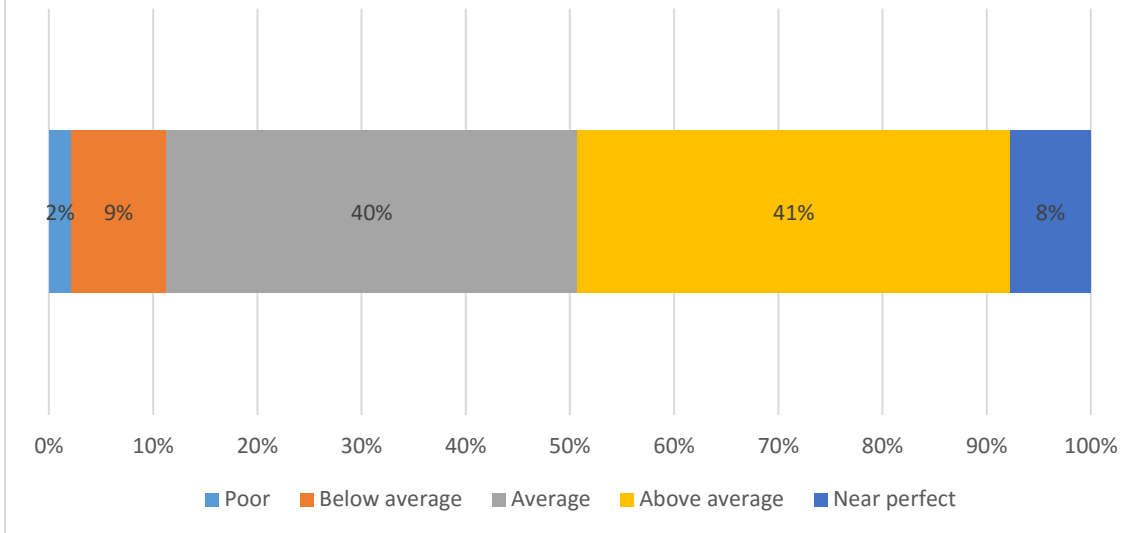

Figure 3: How many days per week do you drive at night (i.e. after the sun has set)



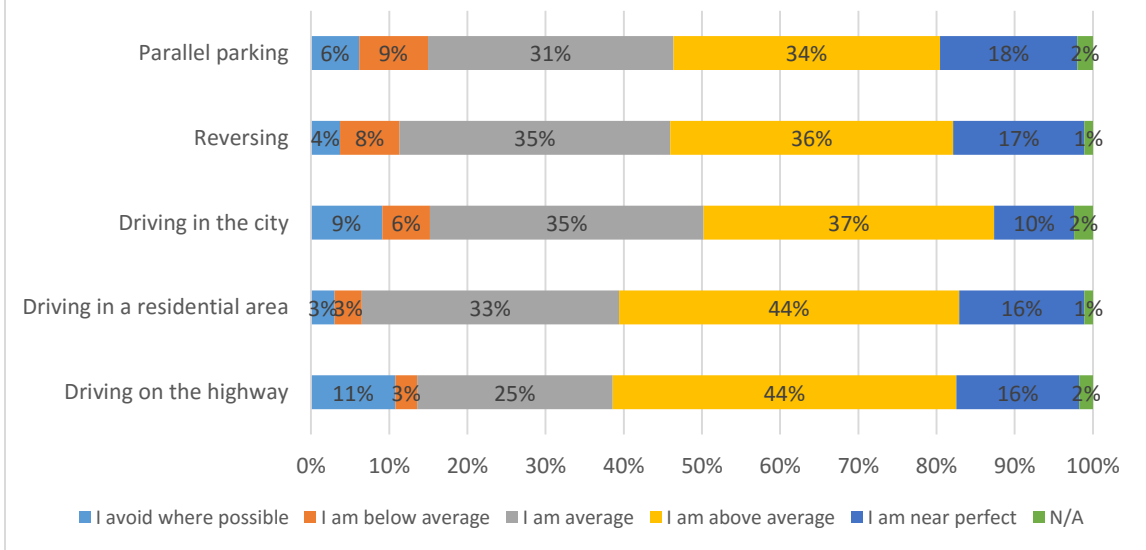

Figure 4: How would you rate your OVERALL driving ability while driving at night?



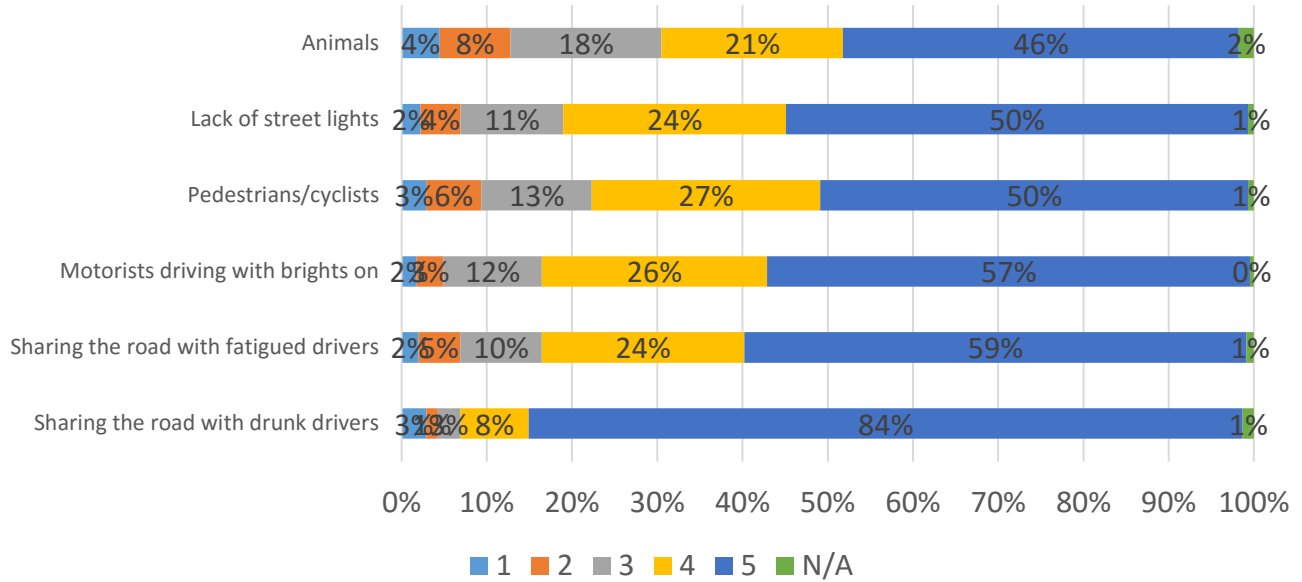

Figure 5: How would you rate YOUR NIGHT TIME driving ability while:



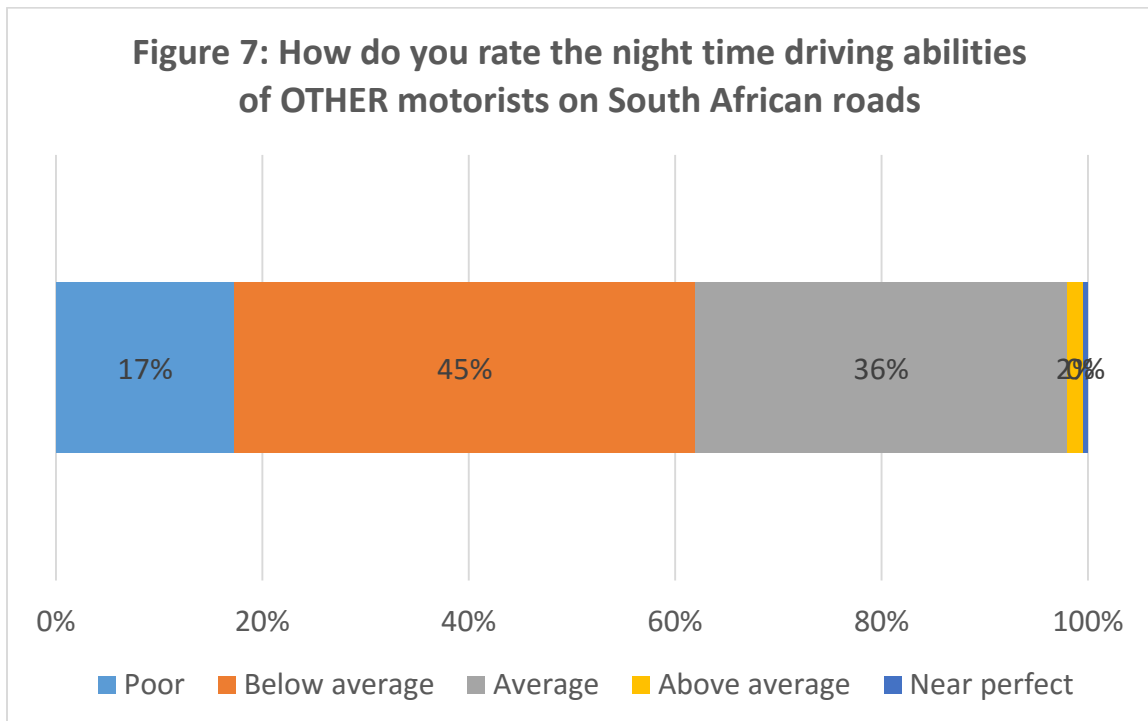
