

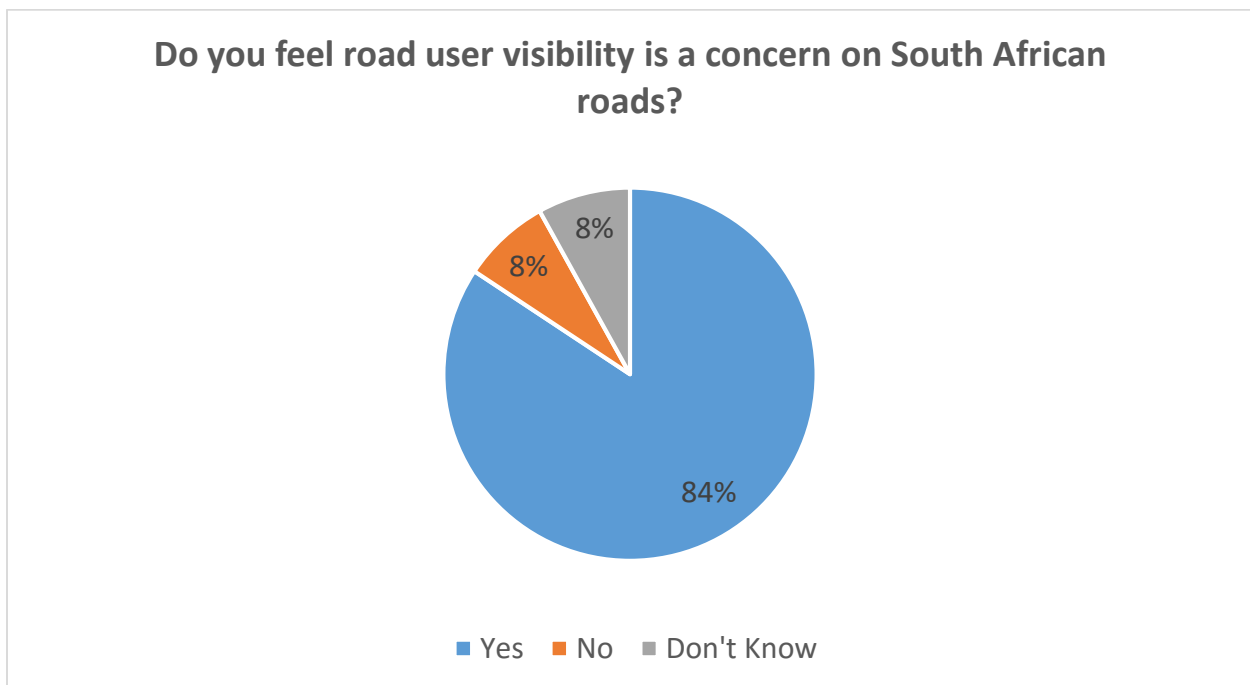

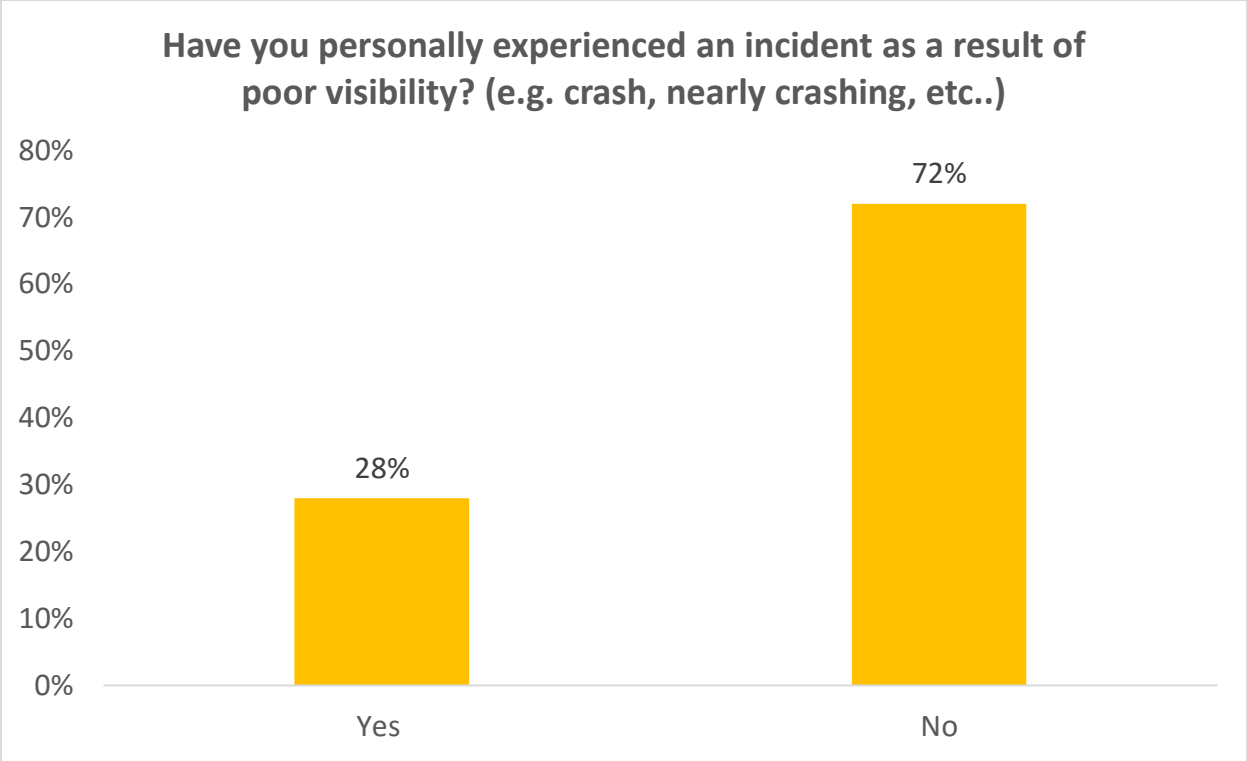
## 1. Overview of current report

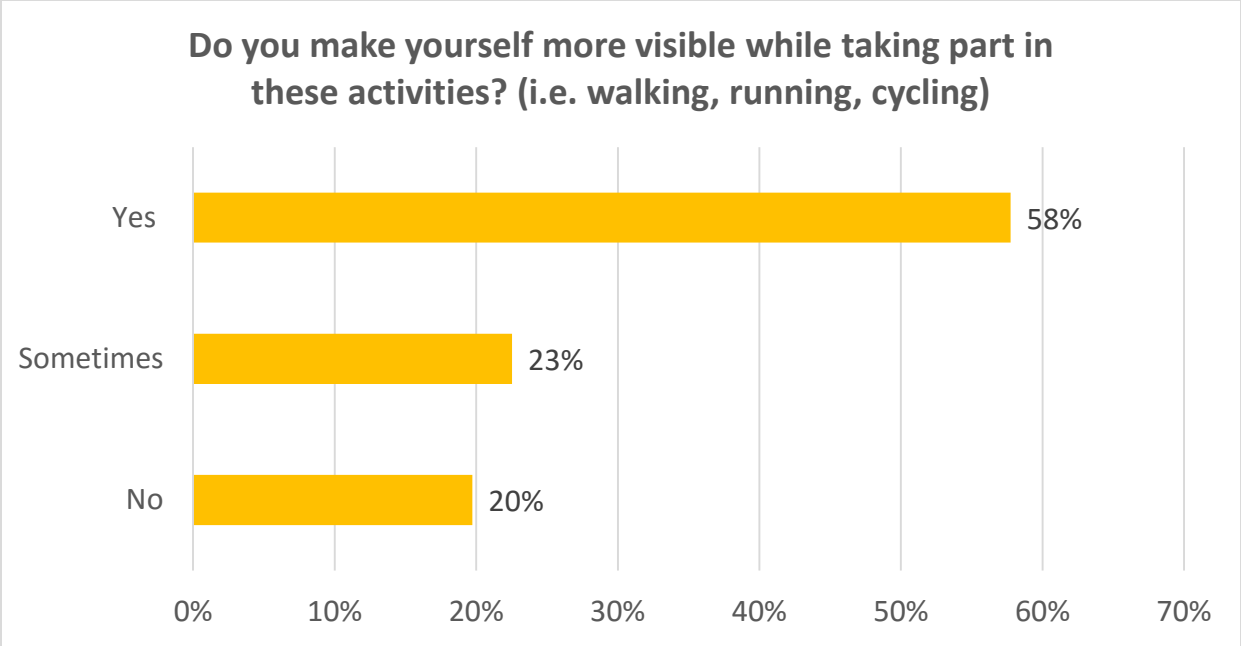

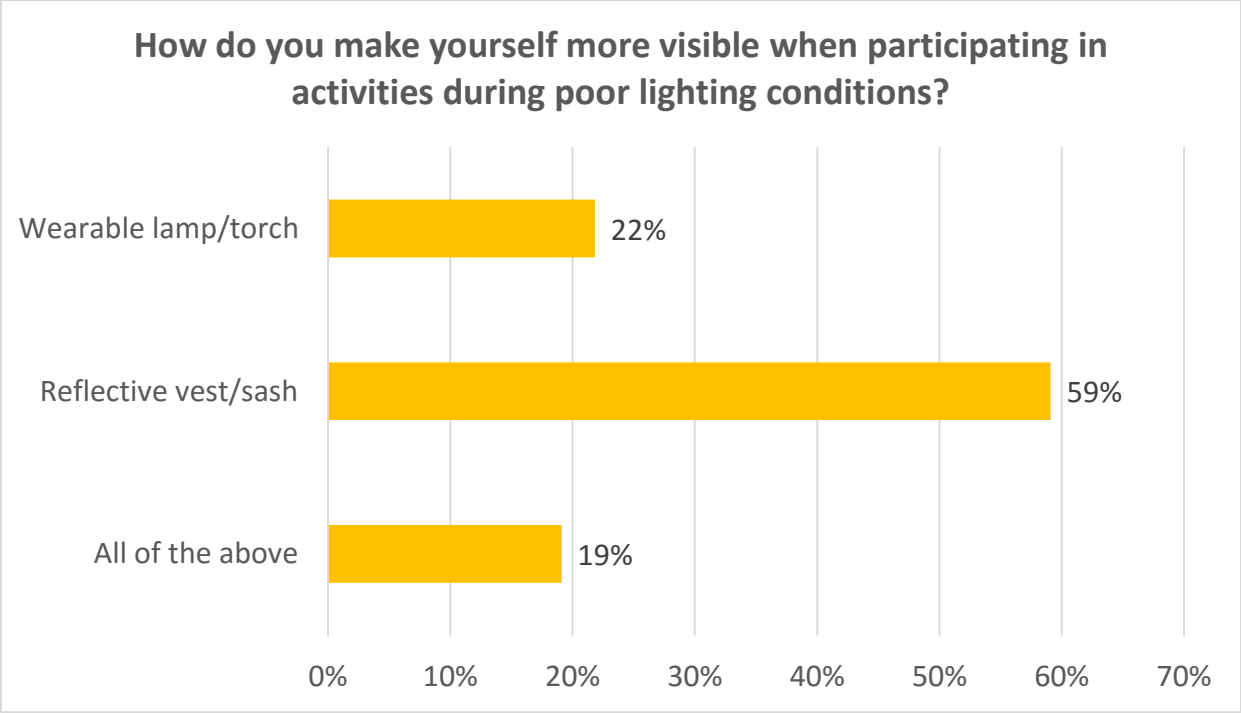

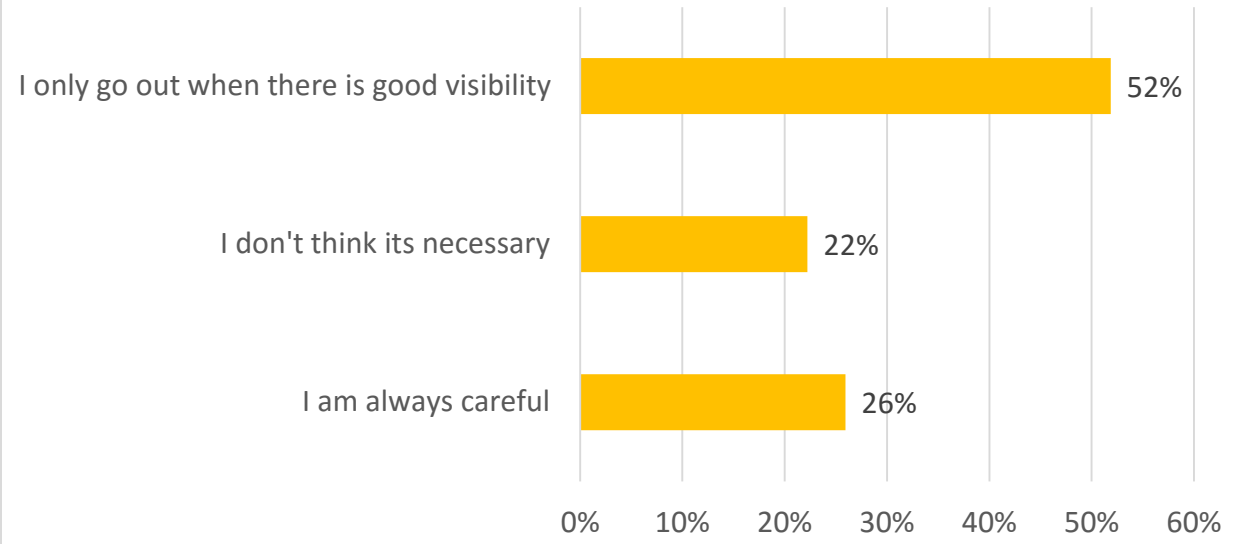

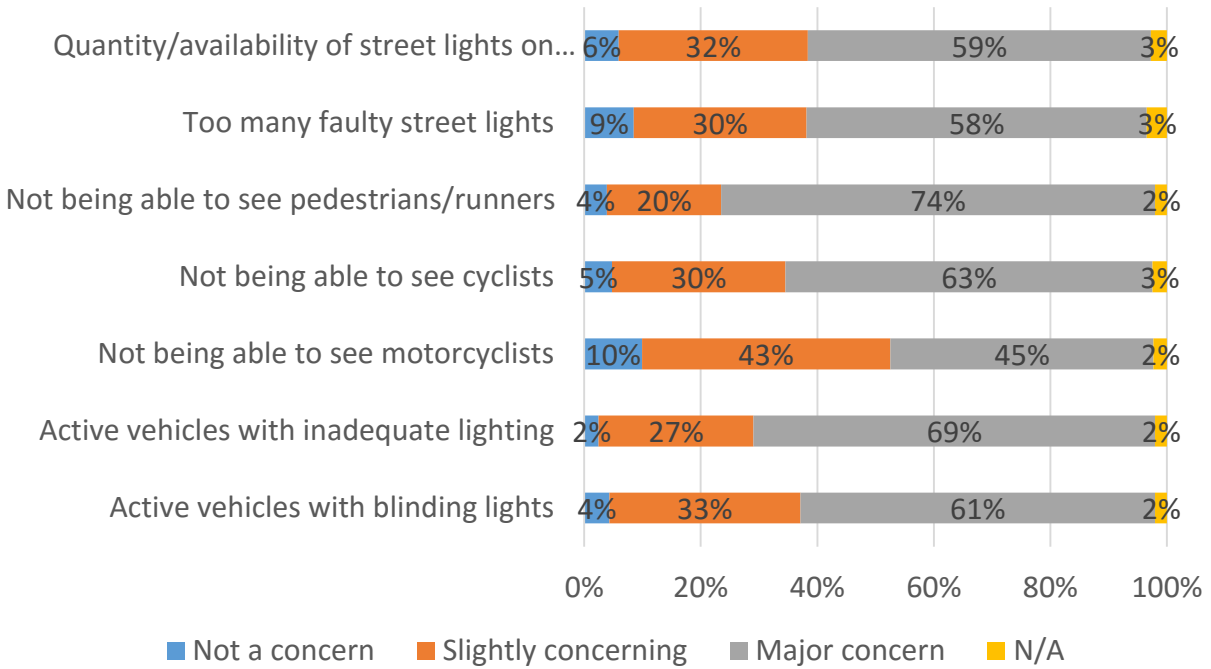
**For those that participate in activities during times of poor lighting, why don't you make yourself more visible?**

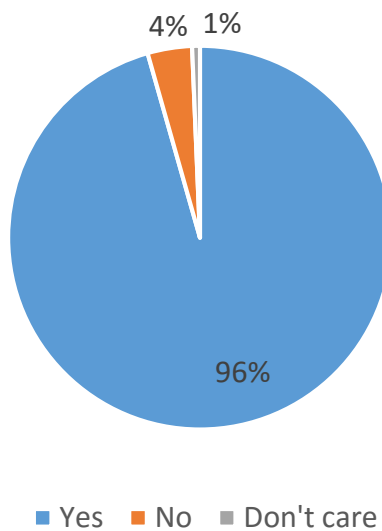
